

ROHS & WEEE Compliance Statement

Since 2006 The European Union (EU) has enacted two Directives. One is concerned with product recycling (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment, WEEE) and the other limits the use of certain substances (Restriction on the use of Hazardous Substances, RoHS). As a customer focused global manufacturer of a wide range of control system products, Horner APG is committed to developing products that comply with the above mentioned Directives.

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive

Horner APG is committed to meeting legal obligations under WEEE and has a program in place to ensure compliance for in scope products.

The Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive

Two categories of products (Categories 8 and 9) within the WEEE Directive are currently exempt from the RoHS Directive. Horner APG products fall under Category 9 (Monitoring and Control Equipment) and currently meet the RoHS directive by exemption.

While our products are currently exempt, Horner believes that eliminating the substances covered in the RoHS Directive is beneficial to our customers, our employees, and the environment. As a result, our Engineering, Purchasing, Manufacturing, and Quality teams are currently working to convert our products and processes to eliminate these substances while at the same time maintaining our standards of quality and functionality. All new designs since 2008 have been designed to be RoHS compliant, mature products that now contain lead free parts are being transitioned from leaded processes to unleaded processes on an ongoing basis.
